

Choosing the Right Ferret Cage

You're intending on adopting a ferret and looking forward to having one of these energetic and inquisitive creatures running around your house, but have you thought about what kind of cage to get him? You could be thinking that the ferret will be out and about, what does he need a cage for? The truth is that ferrets could possibly get into a lot of difficulties and it simply is not really safe to let your pet ferret run around the house without supervision. When you are at home and can rescue him from any awkward situation he might get into, it can be fine to let your pet out and he will probably keep you amused with his antics, but whenever you won't be home the safest location for him is within his cage so it is best to be sure to buy him one which he will enjoy being in. There are many different size cages for ferrets and many that offer various features. Above all, you must be sure that the cage you choose for your ferret is safe and sound. It should be made of metal with bars small enough to ensure he can't squeeze out or get his head caught. It must also have solid floors, or a plastic liner that you are able to put down on the bottom. Make sure that your your pets cage is big enough for him to move around in. Ideally, you would want to get him one with different platforms and that is big enough to house sufficient toys so that he will not get bored if you are not home to keep him amused. Ensure that there is enough room for the litter box, food and water dishes along with a bed. The cage ought to be at the very least 2 feet square, but the bigger the better. Don't attempt to house your ferret in a glass aquarium tank - those work for hamsters but your ferret needs breathable living space around him. Also make certain there isn't any sharp edges that he could get cut on. When it comes to food and drinking water containers, ferrets will make a mess so you might like to choose a water bottle or at least purchase a very heavy pan that he cannot tip over. If you really want to get your ferret a high class cage, there are a good deal of to pick from. You can get multi level cages with platforms and tubes that your ferret can scamper out and in of. You can even buy cages that start as a basic 1 level cage and then obtain add on levels whenever you feel like your pet needs more play space or as your ferret family grows. You should have your cage selected and in place before you bring your ferret home. Try and purchase the biggest and best quality cage you can. Plan for the future because ferrets are addicting and you might find yourself adopting another little critter so you might like to have a cage large enough to accommodate both of them right from the beginning.
